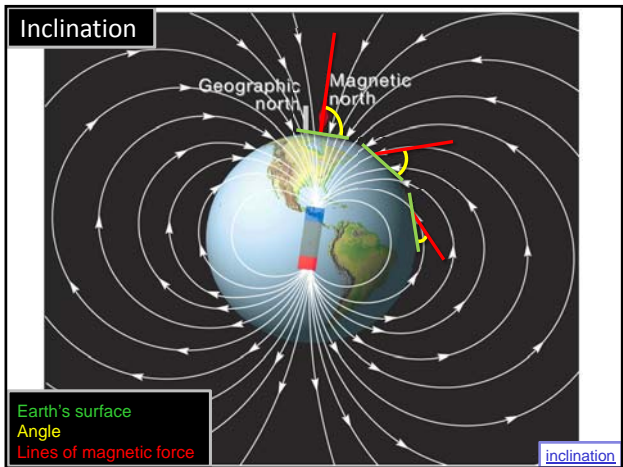
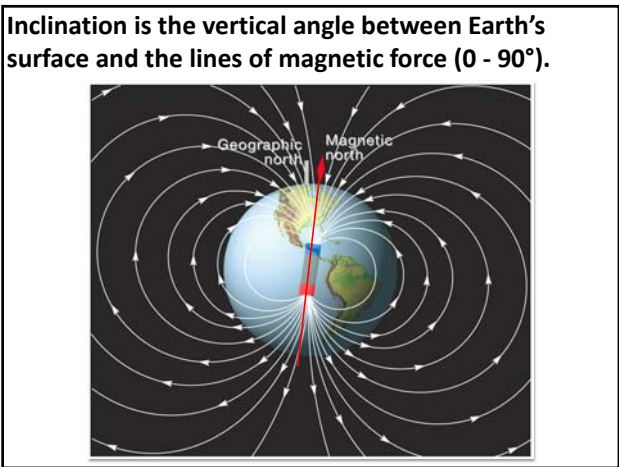


20 Sep 2016: Declination = 14° 40' W changing by 4' E per year.
